My dear friends in Christ,

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to a new initiative. The Catholic Worldview Fellowship is an attractive apostolate that seeks to network, form and empower university students as the next generation of Christian leaders. The month-long Summer Fellowship Program is built upon 4 major areas of formation: spiritual, academic, leadership and cultural.

Spiritual: The Fellowship is anchored in Catholic Spirituality. There is daily prayer, mass, spiritual formation and personal dialogue provided by priests and consecrated women from the Regnum Christi Movement.

Academic: Students receive three academic credits from the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum. The course elaborates upon and transmits a Catholic Worldview through an interdisciplinary study of culture change.

Leadership: Fellowship participants receive personal leadership coaching, identify their talents more clearly and learn how to unleash their leadership potential.

Cultural: The course includes three weeks at Schloss Wissen, a picturesque castle in the German Rhineland with origins dating back to the 14th century and one week in Rome, the epicenter of Catholicism. There are occasions for fieldwork and cultural outings to well-known cultural sights (ex: Aachen, Cologne, Trier, Münster, Xanten, etc...).

I endorse and recommend this program and I ask that you consider collaborating with the organizers of this Fellowship as an opportunity for students' on-going leadership development.
